Objectives:

To assist the relationships and life of the local community and increase the ability to enforce its interests. To improve the circumstances of disadvantaged people and facilitate their re/integration into the community. To successfully implement public care policies within local communities. To increase Euro-Atlantic integration. To encourage a more comprehensive social policy reform.

Activities:

To organise community and cultural events for the people of Rákóczifalva in order to serve the interests of our inhabitants and fulfil their demands, with special emphasis on actively including children and young people in the village’s community life, organise arts groups and crafts activities, literary, reading and debating societies, summer camps and exhibitions. The association wishes to pay increased attention to the situation of children and young people, and help them to enforce their interests. We focus on supporting and improving children with social and emotional disadvantages, learning difficulties and behavioural problems, contribute to embracing diversity. The association also supports parents in tackling these issues. We wish to promote talented local artists, enrich the knowledge on local history, raise awareness on local tourism and explore tourism potentials, demonstrate the exceptional values of our local society even on a national and international level, as well as assist the relationships of local communities. We organise trainings, courses and educational lectures. Another activity is to extend the knowledge on our local history.

We help to reintegrate people with social and employment disadvantages into society, restore their emotional stability.

The association wishes to ease social disadvantages, resulting from injuries or disabilities, by providing employment and income (rehabilitation employment) for people with disabilities. It also intensively promotes health, as our basic value.

Another area – in cooperation with the old people’s day-care centre – is to actively involve our old people by encouraging them to have a positive outlook on life. We wish to improve the relationship between young and old people.

The association carries out nature- and environmental protection activities, organises useful recreational programmes, promotes Euro-Atlantic integration, safeguards human and animal rights, helps ethnic minorities living in Hungary and assists Hungarians living abroad to maintain their identity.
